

# Waiver Renewals

- ❖ The Comprehensive (residential) and Community Support Waiver are both required to be renewed by July 1, 2016.
- ❖ DMH will update the waivers for compliance with the new HCBS rule.
- ❖ Public forums will be held in the month of July.
  - ❖ Anytime is a good time to share unintentional problems with waivers, here is a public opportunity for families to share that information.
- ❖ Comment summary and responses to the public forums will be developed in August.
- ❖ Waivers will be posted to the website in the fall for the official 30 day public comment period.
- ❖ Medicaid will submit to CMS by April 1, 2016.

# MHC/HHC Consolidation



- ❖ Bid award extended on June 30<sup>th</sup> for the HHC improvements.
  - ❖ Pre-construction meeting scheduled for July 20<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ MHC– Slater homes should be completed in August.
- ❖ MHC – Spainhower will be vacated for the upcoming school year to allow Marshall Public Schools to utilize the building.
- ❖ Still estimating to have all non-crisis individuals off of MHC by December 15<sup>th</sup>.
