

MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH A BLUEPRINT FOR THE NEXT ADMINISTRATION

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1. Continue to manage critical initiatives, e.g.:

- Build new high security facility at Fulton State Hospital
- Finish consolidation of Marshall and Higginsville Habilitation Centers
- Comply with new Federal HCBS waiver rule regarding community integration
- Further integrate physical and behavioral health care (e.g., expand health homes)
- Continue to improve movement of SORTS residents through the treatment continuum
- Pursue waiver for expanding Medicaid to young people with early MI and SUDs
- Expand Medication Assisted Treatment for people with SUDs across all of DMH
- Develop service model for children in foster care

2. Plan for and implement *Excellence in Mental Health Act*

3. Implement new model for people with complex MI-DD conditions

4. Enhance voice of consumers and employees

- Make better use of social media
- Improve data analytics

5. Move all of DMH to a trauma-informed system of care

6. Grow the DMH workforce

- Create a virtual DMH training academy
- Develop a strategy for succession planning
- Create a clear path for consumers to move into careers in the DMH system
- Work with colleges and universities on *Caring for Missourians' Mental Health v. 2.0*

7. Create strategy for growth and sustainability of Recovery Support Services and Consumer Operated Service Programs
