Recovery Support Access Program Services

Assessment ATRA \$143.30 QSAP

ATR Assessment, Individual, \$143.30. This service is only available to ATR4 access programs. Within the first 30 days of admission the ATR4 Access program shall conduct a comprehensive assessment of each ATR 4 consumer. The purpose of this assessment is to assure the consumer receives treatment, recovery services and referral to community resources that will lead to success in the recovery domains of; Sobriety, Housing, Legal Status, Employment and Social connectedness. The assessment shall include:

- Interview with a Qualified Substance Abuse Professional (QSAP).
- Initial formation of the consumer's person-centered recovery plan.
- GPRA -DCI baseline interview.

Documentation of this completed assessment shall include:

- *Assessment note entered in CIMOR RS billing system.*
- *ATR 4 GPRA-DCI baseline entered in CIMOR*
- *Individualized Recovery Plan.*

Assessment Update ATRAU \$54.90 QSAP

ATR Assessment Update, Individual, \$54.90. This service is only available to ATR4 access programs. Within the first 30 days of admission the Recovery Support Access site shall conduct a review of the comprehensive assessment less than 6 months old. The purpose of this review is to assure the consumer receives treatment, recovery services and referral to community resources that will lead to success in the recovery domains of; Sobriety, Housing, Legal Status, Employment and Social connectedness. The assessment-update shall include:

- Review of the existing Addiction Severity Index, ASI-MV or ASAM Criteria Software.
- Interview with a Qualified Substance Abuse Professional (QSAP).
- Initial formation of the consumer's person-centered recovery plan.
- GPRA /DCI intake interview if required.

Documentation of this completed assessment shall include:

- *Assessment review-update note entered in CIMOR RS billing system.*
- *ATR 4 GPRA/DCI Intake.*
- *Recovery Plan.*

Recovery Coordination ATRRCR \$20.00/month

Recovery Coordination-Individual, \$20.00/ month. This service is delivered only by individuals who have completed ATR Recovery Coordinator training. This service is only available to ATR4 access programs. This service involves assuring ATR required activities are conducted such as; GPRA-DCI, assessment, recovery plan creation, recovery plan management, voucher creation, voucher management, consumer advocacy, recovery management check-ups, obtaining consumer locator data and conducting consumer tracking activities. The recovery coordinator assures person-centered planning involves the consumer as an active participant, assuring the consumer helps determine their level of care, their service array and has choice of provider. The recovery coordinator maintains contact with the consumer every two-four weeks until collection of the six month GPRA/DCI reassessment to assure the services authorized by voucher are delivered and the consumer achieves recovery as measured by successful outcomes in the areas of; Abstinence/Sobriety, Stable housing, Employment, Lawful lifestyle and Socially Connected.

- This service may only be delivered by ATR4 access programs.
- This service may only be delivered by an ATR approved staff member who has received Recovery Coordination training. (GPRA/DCI, consumer locator, tracking and recovery management check-up)
- This is an individual service and may be delivered face to face, via telephone communication or other confidential method of electronic communication.

Documentation includes a report of the month's recovery coordination activities entered in the CIMOR recovery support billing system.

Recovery Plan Follow-up ATRRPF \$41.60/ event

Recovery Plan Follow-up, Individual, \$41.60/event. This service is only available to ATR4 access programs. This service is delivered only by individuals who are ATR approved and GPRA-DCI trained. This service involves a recovery management check-up, collection of the reassessment GPRA-DCI and a review of the consumer's recovery progress in the areas of; Abstinence/Sobriety, Stable housing, Employment, Lawful lifestyle and Socially Connectedness.

- This service is an individual service and may be delivered face to face or via telephone communication.

Documentation includes a completed GPRA-DCI reassessment/follow-up in CIMOR.
