

## January 26, 2012 MSAPCB Board meeting Recap

1. Interventionist Training- We will set up a 2 day Interventionist Training for late October 2012 that would provide the 14 training hours necessary for someone to apply to the Association of Intervention Specialists for a Board Registered Interventionist (BRI) credential. (This would not meet all of the BRI requirements an applicant needs but only the training requirement)
2. DOT Substance Abuse Professional (SAP) - We will contract with the Substance Abuse Program Administrators Association (SAPAA) to promote their DOT SAP training and exam process. For each Missouri individual who uses SAPAA to obtain the SAP designation and uses our referral code, we will receive \$59.00. In addition, for each individual who takes SAPAA's 12 hour SAP refresher training for continuing education requirements, we will receive \$25.00.
3. Clinical Supervision Training – We will move from our current required clinical supervision training model to the new National ATTC Supervision model. This model is 14 online hours of training followed by a 2 day live 16 hour training. We will add an additional 3<sup>rd</sup> day to the live training (5 hours) that will cover TAP 21 specifics and MSAPCB credentialing processes. Scott will be picking 5 trainers in addition to himself to attend a Training of Trainers (TOT) in Kansas City May 9-11, 2012. The MATTC will cover all expenses for the TOT. After the TOT in May, we will make announcements to the field and shift to the new model.
