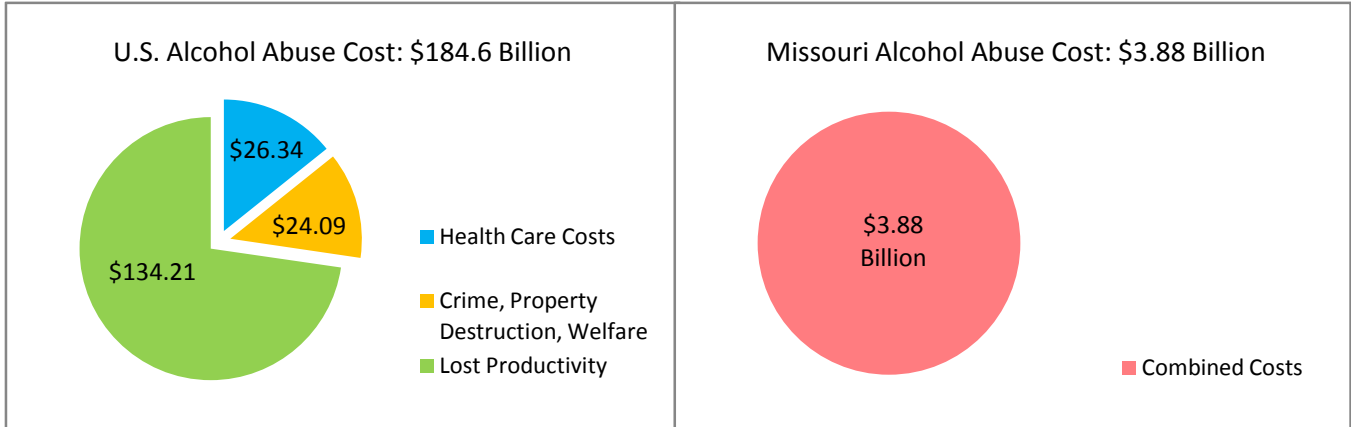


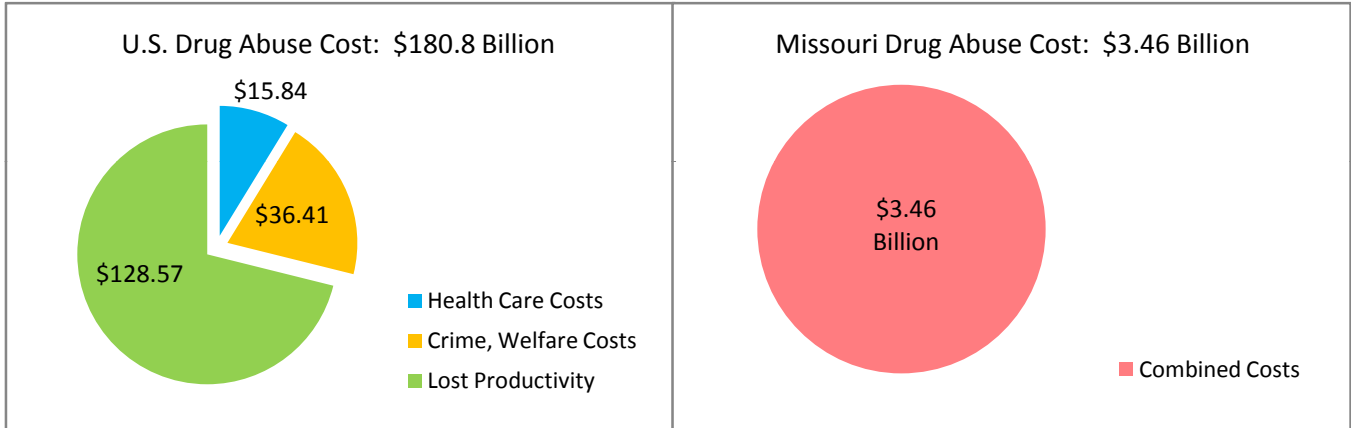

Estimated Annual Economic Cost of Alcohol Abuse in the United States and Missouri, in Billions of Dollars



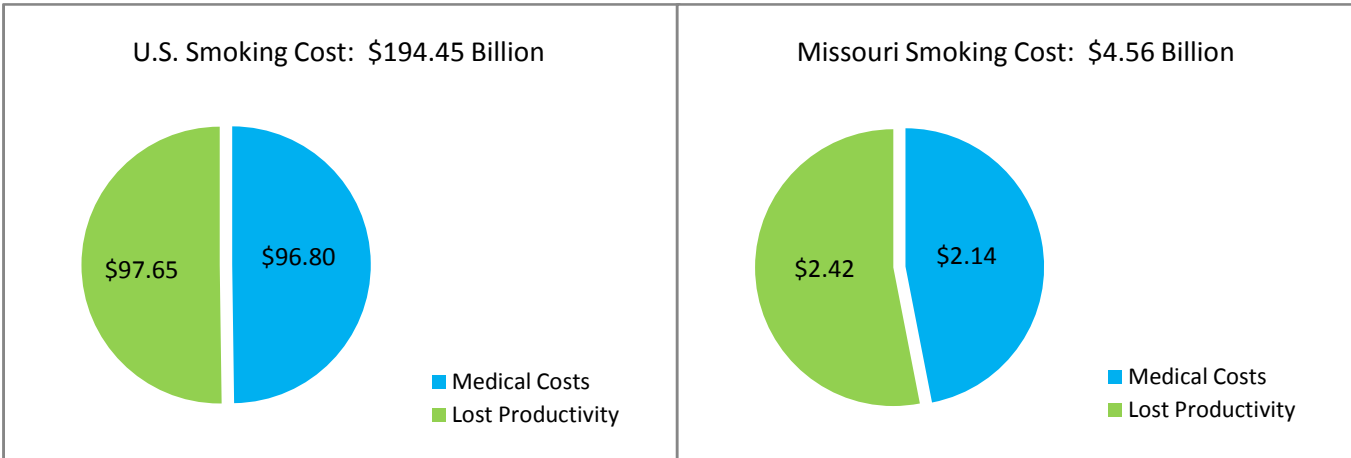
