MO HealthNet for Kids refers to the statewide program for low-income children, uninsured children through CHIP, and children in the custody of the state. Children receive a full comprehensive package including primary, acute and preventive care, hospital care, dental, prescriptions, and vision and receive their care through either the Fee-for-Service (FFS) or the Managed Care (MC+) delivery system, depending on where the individual lives in Missouri (additional information in Guide below).
