Autism Spectrum Disorders: Screening and Referral

This online learning experience is the second in a series of autism training modules and focuses on screening for Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). It also describes the next steps if referral for further evaluation is needed. Health care providers, childcare providers, school personnel, family members, and others who interact with young children are encouraged to take this training module to learn more about this process.

The module is hosted on the University of Missouri Extension web site. To view the training you will need to register for an Extension Passport and select the Autism Spectrum Disorders: Screening and Referral course to view. There is no charge for the Passport or to view the training.

The Screening and Referral training was developed by the Mid-Missouri Rapid Response Initiative, which is funded by the Missouri Department of Mental Health Division of Developmental Disabilities. An online module was created from the training through a partnership with the MU Thompson Center for Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders, University of Missouri Extension, and the Division of Developmental Disabilities Office of Autism Services. This project also was supported in part by a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration [grant number H6MMC11059].
