<p>Call To Order</p> <p>Division Director Update/ Discussion</p> <p>Budget Update</p>	<p>Bruce Charles called the meeting to order with self introductions.</p> <p>Steve Reeves, Division Deputy Director</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Steve spoke about the amount of revenue collections and they are not at a level the Governors' office or state would have thought. This could affect next year's budget. • FSH-a package was decided on with repayment up to 25 years. • HB 1779-Advanced Practice Registered Nurse in state facilities can administer restraint and seclusion orders. • HB 509-tax cuts up to \$620 million and by 2017 possibly another \$250 million. • HB 1243-allows criminal penalties against sexual predators for acts of violence on staff at state facilities. • HB 1826-Clinical Psychologist can be on Mental Health Commission. • HB 2667-Established a new department-MO HealthNet. <p>Laurie Epple, Deputy Director of Administration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPS & ADA Budget both grew. Total \$778 million dollars • \$15.9 for Strengthening Mental Health • 2 FTE for 2 Psychiatric Resident Spots at UMPC, Columbia • Cape Girardeau County to partner with Community Counseling. Have not had anyone evicted because of this. Hopefully the RFP process will be back on schedule. • Submitted 28 renewal grants. Have seen an increase in the fair market rate. This usually means more individuals can be served. • Section 811-The Missouri Housing Development Commission-they submitted RFP. Requested \$7.5 million dollars. That would be a huge boost to the subsidies. <p>Bianca Farr-Director of Employment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applied for an \$800 thousand grant. If we received the grant we would start two new evidence based supported employment programs-Jefferson City & St. Charles. Should hear about grant reward by Oct. 1. <p>Jon Sabala, Veterans Services Director</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jon provided a presentation on the goal to reduce the barriers to behavioral health services for Service Members, Veterans and their Families.
