NOTE 2: Habilitation Center Program Changes

- **The Nevada Habilitation Center (NHC) in October 2012 transitioned all individuals to community living settings. NHC, now known as Southwest Community Services, continues to provide day program services for the residents, and oversight of the community residential programs.**
- **The Division of Developmental Disabilities consolidated the St. Louis Developmental Disabilities Treatment Center from three sites down to two sites by closing the Northwest Habilitation Center campus in Overland. Individuals were transitioned to community living settings or other ICF/MR beds in the St. Louis area. The campus was closed in October 2012.**
- **Mental Health Commission established Northwest Habilitation Services Task Force to review and evaluate services currently provided by the Marshall Habilitation Center and the Higginsville Habilitation Center. The task force will recommend a design to the Commission that will best meet the needs of the individuals served and will optimize the use of all available resources.**
