Dr. Martin Maldonado is an infant, child and adolescent psychiatrist and family therapist. He works at the Child and Family Behavioral Health Unit, Truman Medical Centers. He is an associate professor of psychiatry, School of Medicine, University of Missouri. Also, he is an adjunct professor for infant psychopathology at the Kansas State University and a clinical professor at the Kansas University School of Medicine. He was a researcher at the Child and Family Center of the Menninger Clinic for several years. He edited the book *Infant and Toddler Mental Health*, published by American Psychiatric Press. He has co-edited or edited five additional books in Spanish on topics of child and infant mental health. Dr. Maldonado has written numerous papers and book chapters on topics of child development and psychopathology in several countries. He currently has an infant mental health clinic at the child and family behavioral health unit at Truman
