

DIAL™-4 Screening and Referral Process—Health Care Provider Edition



All Well Child Visits: Perform Developmental Surveillance

American Academy of Pediatrics Guidelines:

- Perform Developmental Screenings at 9, 18, and 24 or 30 month well child visits (ex. ASQ-3).
- Perform Autism Specific Screen at 18 and 24 months or when concerns (ex. MCHAT).
- Screen for social & emotional development at any well child visit (ex. ASQ:SE).

DIAL™-4 Recommendations:

- DIAL Screening is appropriate for children 30 months to 71 months.
- Screening should be performed at least on a yearly basis.

DIAL-4 Results & Next Steps:

Screening and referral process should be done in partnership with the family, & be based on individual child's needs. If family has concerns, please refer to appropriate services, regardless of screening test result.
