

# Universal Screening/Assessment and Referral Process-Early Childhood Service Provider Edition



- Perform Developmental Screenings at intervals recommended by the screening tool (ex. ASQ-3™).
- Screen for social & emotional development at intervals recommended by the screening tool (ex. ASQ:SE™).

## Screening/Assessment Results & Next Steps:

Screening and referral process should be done in partnership with the family, & be based on individual child’s needs. If family has concerns, please refer to appropriate services, regardless of screening test result.
