RE: Community Mental Health Treatment and Offenders with Serious Mental Illness Programs

The corresponding bulletin provides an overview of the Community Mental Health Treatment (CMHT) and Offenders with Serious Mental Illness (OSMI) programs. Updates to the programs are included within. The bulletin may be found on the Community Provider Bulletin Board under memos.

A few highlights are listed below:

- CMHT was previously referred to as MH3.
- OSMI program was previously referred to as MH4.
- As soon as the Administrative Agent (AA) receives a referral for one of the programs, the appropriate program (CPS DOC MH3 or CPS DOC MH4 Pre-Release) should be opened in CIMOR.
- Upon receiving a referral, the AA should immediately begin discharge planning including coordination of housing and linkage to services. Discharge planning is billable.
- If offender is OSMI and has been released from the Department of Corrections (DOC), the CPS DOC MH4 Pre-Release program should be closed in CIMOR and CPS DOC MH4 Post-Release program should be opened.
- If the offender becomes Medicaid or CPR eligible, the DOC program should be closed in CIMOR and the CPR/CPS program should be opened.

Please note you may see a slight increase in the OSMI program due to the new criteria being implemented.
