OPEN DISCUSSION	<p>Kathy Carter, Karl Wilson, and Steve Roling are very impressed with the DMH Leadership Academy and expressed their regret that they were not able to attend in person.</p>
DIRECTOR'S UPDATE	<p>Mark Stringer provided a Director's update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The McKinsey Consulting Firm is working under a Rapid Response contract with Mo HealthNet. DMH is a member of the pharmacy, Medicaid financing, managed care, and the long term services and support groups. Other groups are focused on Medicaid eligibility and Medicaid fraud. The early meetings have been focused on gathering information from the agencies and asking questions. Today, Mark, Debra, Rick Gowdy, Tim Rudder, Dr. Angeline Stanislaus and Dr. Rachel Winograd met with representatives from the McKinsey Consulting Firm which focused on gathering information on DMH's efforts regarding the opioid epidemic. No recommendations have been made yet. Prior to recommendations being public, draft recommendations will be shared with the Department.
