RE: Metabolic Screening of the ADA DM Population

The corresponding bulletin provides policy guidance for implementation of the Metabolic Syndrome Screening (MBS) to the ADA DM population enrolled in either a CSTAR or CPR program.

The MBS has been a valuable tool in identifying chronic conditions among individuals served in Division of Behavioral Health (DBH) programs. Identification of these chronic conditions allows for a more concerted treatment plan and better care coordination among multiple specialty providers. Delivering holistic, integrated treatment to the individuals we serve has proven to be invaluable and lifesaving.


By now all ADA DM providers should have purchased their Cholestech LDX machines. You will receive training directly from the vendor on how to operate the machine. The DBH and the Coalition for Community Behavioral Healthcare will be scheduling upcoming training on MBS data collection and reporting.

Attached you will find preliminary data showing the chronic disease prevalence for the ADA DM and the DM3700 populations. The data clearly shows the need for statewide MBS policy for both of these populations.


