Behavioral Health Division Director’s Report Budget Update	<p>Nora Bock, Director, Adult Community Treatment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nora spoke about the transition and the new division director. So far the transition has been very smooth. • Received a Partnership for success grant of \$1.6 million-5 yrs. To prevent or reduce substance use (includes prescription drug misuse) to promote mental, emotional, and behavioral wellbeing of youth. Will be in the SE part of the state-5 community based non-profit prevention agencies will be involved. These include-Family Counseling Center, Prevention Consultants of Missouri, SEMO State University, SEMO Behavioral Health and The National Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse. • Block Grant Application-The application is due Sept. 1. • Division is working hard on two initiatives-Excellence in Mental Health Act planning grant and an 1115 waiver-established population to become Medicaid eligible. This has to be cost neutral. <p>Vicki Schollmeyer, Director of Operations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General revenue collections grew • SB 509 will have some impact but not sure what it is yet. <p>Mark Stringer, Department Director</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$1 million grant-medication assisted treatment services-to federally qualified health centers. Providers should be watching to see if the FQHC in their area applies for these funds. • There are currently federal bills that would change the number of beds from 16 or less to be Medicaid reimbursable.

ADA DM	<p>Tara Crawford, Integrated Care Liaison</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tara updated the committee on the DM 3700 and ADA DM. There are currently 3,738 individuals enrolled in the program. • The average cost savings is \$22.8 million for the first year, \$26.1 million the second year, and \$18.2 million the third year. • Tara also shared some success stories from individual who are enrolled in the program and what a difference it made in their lives. 	
Committee Workgroup Reports	<p>Prevention Workgroup-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Susan applied for a \$1.6 million a year grant. Grant would cover prescription drug use. Will be done in Jefferson County & Southern Missouri. <p>Treatment Workgroup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trainings are being scheduled for the MRSS(P). <p>Missouri Recovery Network</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MRN Annual Recovery Advocacy Day is in the planning state. Tentative dates are Feb 23 or 24 2016. • Helped open a new women's recovery house I Jeff city called The Healing House and new Beginnings. It is a 12 month program and houses 8 women. • Received a SAMHSA grant to establish a statewide peer learning collaborative network. Have hired 8 peer outreach specialists (MRSS-P). Have hosted 2 webinars to engage peers. A statewide peer leadership conference is planned for the spring 2016. • Assisted with a 40 hour CIT training in Jeff City, June 15-19. Educated 35 law enforcement from 6 surrounding counties on how to deescalate • A meeting is scheduled with DOC Leadership team to discuss the utilization of peers in the DOC setting.
