	<p>initiative. The new Youth Behavioral Health Liaison positions are a result of many calls from schools and juvenile courts about challenging youth behaviors. The position is being piloted at Crider Pathways for six months before moving forward with statewide implementation. She expressed a desire to return to a Joint ADA/CPS SAC in a couple of months to provide an update on the lessons learned from this six month pilot implementation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She described the use of Mental Health Block Grant dollars (approximately \$400,000) for services focused on young adults with First Episode Psychosis. The age range of the population is 16-25. Three Assertive Community Treatment teams for Transition Aged Youth are located in Burrell Central (Columbia), Burrell Southwest (Springfield), and Pathways Cass County (Raymore).
