COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Death Review Processes training is a one-half day program for DBH contracted providers, emphasizing the incident management model and performance improvement processes.

2. Provider contracts and amendments.
3. The expectations for providers.
4. The role of DBH staff.
5. Accreditation.
6. The incident management model.
7. The utilization of resources and tools.
8. The development and implementation of performance improvement plans.
9. Aggregate data analysis.

This includes staff who develop and implement policies and procedures related to death reviews, as well as staff who actually conduct death reviews.
