

DECA Assessment and Referral Process—Early Childhood Service Provider Edition

DECA Assessment Administration Recommendations:

- Assess children 1 month to 36 months with the DECA-Infant/Toddler Assessment.
- Assess children 3 years up to 6 years old with the DECA-P2 Assessment.
- Re-assess children every 4 months (or adjust based on 3 times per school year).

DECA Assessment (I/T & P2) Results & Next Steps:

Screening and referral process should be done in partnership with the family, & be based on individual child's needs. If family has concerns, please refer to appropriate services, regardless of screening test result.

Facilitated Referral* for further evaluation and/or services <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Primary Healthcare Provider and/or; • Home visiting program and/or; • Early intervention services and/or; • Inclusions Services and/or; • Mental Health provider (ex. LCSW, LPC, Psy.D., LMFT, etc.) 2. Implement activities from the DECA Strategies Guidebook in the class/care environment 3. Provide family with activities for building competencies in social and emotional development (<i>For Now and Forever</i> guide provided in DECA Kit) 4. Perform developmental screen (ASQ-3) 5. Re-assess every 4 months/3 times per year
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***Facilitated Referral –**

1. Have staff assist parent with making referral.
2. Send information related to screening results to referral.
3. Follow up with referral source to ensure referral received, appointment occurred and to obtain results.
