Revenue Update

- In December 2014, the Governor, House Budget Chairman and Senate Appropriations Chairman agreed on a Consensus Revenues Estimate (CRE) of \$8.673 billion, which represents growth of 3.6% over the revised FY15 estimate.
- December 2015 General Revenue Report:
 - FY 2016 net general revenue collections increased 2.6% compared to FY 2015
 - ➤ Net individual income tax collections increased 5.4%
 - ➤ Net sales and use tax collections increased 1.9%
 - ➤ Net corporate income and franchise tax collections decreased 24.6%
 - ➤ Net all other collections decreased 24.1%
 - Refunds increased 27.6%

Budget Update
