

# AGENCY TIERED SUPPORTS (ATS)

#### How much does it cost?

ATS is a <u>free</u> program offered throughout the State of Missouri by your regional Agency Tiered Supports Consultants Team from the Department of Mental Health, Division of Developmental Disabilities.

#### How will this benefit my agency?

The ATS program offers you a one-on-one Agency Tiered Support Consultant who will support your agency through assessment, education, and will be an ongoing resource for your team. The benefits vary depending on your agency's desired focus area some common outcomes are: data-based decision making, action planning, leadership skills, coaching programs, and training.

## WHAT IS TOOLS OF CHOICE?

TOOLS of Choice is a <u>free</u> 18-hour course, divided into six three-hour skills based sessions.

✓ Available to any support staff, caregiver, community member, or professional.


#### Objectives:

- ✓ To educate about "behavior," develop concrete strategies to strengthen relationships, build de-escalation skills to ensure safety and success in handling difficult situations, and provide ongoing support to ensure competency and confidence.
- ✓ Examples and tips on how to effectively handle difficult behaviors and make them less likely to happen in the future
- ✓ Teach simple interaction skills to build relationships that increase positive interactions




# COST OF TOOLS OF CHOICE






# Impact and efficiency Measures for Tiered Supports Initiative



This data shows that all tiered agencies experienced a significant decrease in reporting behavioral incidents as compared to the agencies that are not participating in the process.

# IMPACT AND EFFICIENCY MEASURES FOR TIERED SUPPORTS INITIATIVE



The staff time cost of documenting and reviewing incident reports was computed based on the estimated hourly wages of the staff typically involved in the documentation process (\$30 per behavioral EMT).

The analysis estimates that the number of behavioral incidents and cost associated is significantly higher for agencies not participating in the tiered supports process demonstrating that the tiered supports initiative is effective in reducing behavior problems.
