- **HB2407 Allen** Transfers and restructures the duties and powers of DHSS to create the Department of MOHealthNet. Hearing 2/29/16 in House Government Efficiency Committee
- HB1892 Rehder Narcotics Control Act— Out of house and first read Senate 3/3/16
- **HB2351 Frederick** Adds psychiatrists to health professional student loan repayment program. Hearing 3/9/16 in House Health and Mental Health Committee
- HB1432 Vecovo Administrative Leave. Harmful impact to DMH investigations. Testified against the bill 1/20 which crossed chambers on 3/7/16
- HB2135 Rhoads EMS provisions. HCS passed out of House State & Local Government
- SB895 Hegeman EMS Training requirements regarding autism, ID/DD and use of temporary holds when transporting patients.
- HB1546 Lauer Suicide awareness/prevention in schools. Policies and training for youth suicide prevention and awareness. Perfected by consent; now in House Rules
- HB1656 Dunn Suicide awareness/prevention training for public school teachers. Now in House Rules
- SB627 Nasheed Suicide awareness/prevention in higher education. On Senate Consent calendar
- SB646 Schupp Suicide awareness/prevention in education. DESE to develop training guidelines/districts adopt policies on youth suicide awareness & prevention education. On Senate Consent Calendar
- HB1923 Barnes Telehealth—includes physicians and psychiatrists
- **HB2464 Monticello** DESE to identify 5 schools for trauma informed school pilot program; Sunsets 2019 Hearing 3/1/16 in House Emerging Issues in Education Committee.

• HB2565 Monticello Requires DESE to create trauma informed schools program and website. Hearing 3/1/16 in House Emerging Issues in Education Committee.
