



Medicaid Annual Renewals

June 2024



- Sometimes 'Medicaid Annual Renewal' is referred to as an annual:
 - ? review
 - @reinvestigation,
 - reauthorization, or
 - # re-certification



- In the month prior to the renewal month (if not renewed exparte), the Family Support Division (FSD) mails an annual renewal form (FA-402 or IM-1U) to the consumer.
- The <u>signed</u> annual renewal form is due back the first working day of the renewal month.
- If the <u>signed</u> annual renewal form is received in the renewal month, the consumer will NOT be closed for failure to submit the form.
- For example: March renewal forms are mailed out in February and due back to FSD on March 1. If the form is received by March 31, eligibility and coverage will continue while on-going eligibility is being determined.

Annual Medicaid Eligibility Renewal FSD Timeline



June Renewa









March 2023

FSD will check cases for updates against the US Postal Service National Change of Address & make updates

April 2023

FSD will start the exparte process to see if FSD can automatically determine a participant's eligibility

May 2023

FSD will mail a decision letter, a pre-populated form, or blank form depending on participant's situation

June 30, 2023

Participants must return pre-populated forms & any documents required by the deadline

Decision Letters

Once FSD determines if a participant is eligible or not, they will get one of the following decision letters:

No Change	We have determined they are still eligible for MO HealthNet coverage. Nothing will change, and there is nothing more they need to do.
Change in Coverage	The participant is still eligible, but a different type of coverage is a better fit. This letter will let them know their new MO HealthNet coverage category and will provide instructions if there is anything they need to do.
Adverse Action	The participant is no longer eligible for MO HealthNet coverage. If they disagree with this decision, they will need to take action by the date listed in the letter.



- When an annual renewal form and verification documents are received within timeline, FSD will make a determination and send a decision letter.
- PSD may send a request for current verification of income (other than Social Security and SSI) and resources (if in a non-MAGI category). It is encouraged to include all verification of income, bank balances, etc. with the annual renewal form to avoid issues.
- If requested verification is not received by the due date, FSD will send a notice that the Medicaid will close in 10 days for failure to provide verification. The client has 30 days from the final date of closure to provide all needed verification.



Renewal Closures



- ## If the case has been closed for failure to return the renewal form and it is still within 90 days of closure.
 - © Submit a renewal form to FSD by uploading on the mydss.mo.gov webpage (an account is recommended).
 - If the signed form is received within 30 day, the closing will be canceled and processing continued.
 - If received on days 31-90, the form will be used as an application to re-determine eligibility.
- † If the annual renewal form is submitted **after 90 days** a new MO HealthNet application must be submitted.



Scenarios

Scenario 1

FSD checked Sarah's information on file and using data from the Insight Engine and found everything needed to continue her MO HealthNet benefit.

Scenario 2

FSD checked Sarah's information on file and using data from the Insights Engine and found there was missing or outdated information.

> FSD mails Sarah a prepopulated annual renewal form 55 days before her renewal is due. She must complete the form, sign it, and provide copies of any verification documents required by the deadline.

After FSD gets Sarah's annual renewal form they will process the information. If Sarah does not meet her deadline, she will get a letter asking her to return the form so FSD does not have to close her case. Sara will then get a decision letter even if she does not return the form.

FSD will mail a decision letter to Sarah.

ELIGIBILE: If Sarah is eligible, there is nothing more she needs to do. Her letter will let her know that her MO HelathNet coverage is renewed. If there is a change in her MO HealthNet coverage type, the letter will also inform Sarah of this.

NOT ELIGIBLE: If Sarah is no longer eligible, her letter will inform her of this decision. If she disagrees, she will have 10 days from the date shown in the letter to submit an appeal.

RE-DETERMINATIONS AFTER CLOSURE: If Sarah sends her annual renewal form within 90 days of FSD closing her case, FSD will accept the form and will complete a re-determination to explore continued eligibility for MO HealthNet coverage. If the form is returned 91+ days after, Sara will have to submit a new application.



Scenario 1

(renewed ex-parte)

- FSD checked Sarah's information on file and found everything needed to continue her MO HealthNet eligibility and coverage at her current benefit level.
- FSD will mail a decision letter to Sarah letting her know she remains eligible and there is nothing more she needs to do. If there is a change in her MO HealthNet coverage category, the letter will also inform Sarah of this.



Scenario 2

(not renewed ex-parte)

- 1. FSD checked Sarah's information on file and found there was missing or outdated information
- 2. FSD mails Sarah an annual renewal form 55 days before her renewal is due. She must complete, sign, and submit the form **by the end of the renewal month**.
- 3. After FSD gets Sarah's annual renewal form they will request needed verification and then process the her eligibility determination.
- 4. If Sarah does not return the renewal form **by the first day of the renewal month**, FSD will send her an adverse action notice that her case will close if she doesn't return the form.
- 5. FSD will mail a decision letter to Sarah after processing her renewal determination
 - If Sarah remains eligible with no change in benefit level, FSD will mail a decision letter to Sarah letting her know she remains eligible and there is nothing more she needs to do. If there is a change in her MO HealthNet coverage category, the letter will also inform Sarah of this.
 - If Sarah is no longer eligible or remains eligible with a change in benefit level (going to spend down or premium category), the letter will be an adverse action notice letting her know if she disagrees with the decision she has **10 days to appeal** before the decision takes effect.



Individuals can return their completed annual renewal form in any of the following ways:

Online: Visit mydss.mo.gov to log in to the FSD Benefit Portal and submit their form or upload their completed, and signed, annual renewal form to myDSSupload.mo.gov

By Mail: Complete and sign their yellow annual renewal form and send it back to the address provided in the letter

In-Person: Return the form to the local FSD Resource Center

Options to Identify Renewal Dates

Annual Reinvestigations Report

- "MedicaidReauths(MEIS)" is a report listing cases for a Medicaid annual renewal the month following the month of the report (for example June 3 report lists cases due July 31). TCM TACs distribute to TCM entities.
- MyDSS https://mydss.mo.gov/
 - User selects 'Check Your Status'
 - Enter DOB and SSN or DCN
- eMOMED https://www.emomed.com/
 - Requires access to eMOMED
 - User selects 'eProvider'
 - Select 'Participant Annual Review Date'
 - Search up to twelve DCNs at a time for renewal date



M-6AR

- A If possible, have the individual (parent/caretaker if individual is a child) sign an IM-6AR naming your agency or a staff person as his or her authorized representative.
- Multiple persons may serve as authorized representative concurrently.
- FSD will send correspondence to the individual and to the authorized representative.
