At-A-Glance Report

Missouri Quality Outcomes were developed as a result of listening to people with disabilities, their families, and advocates. The Outcomes were designed to encourage personal quality of life outcomes with individual focus on leading a self-determined life; including personal values, choice, health, safety, inclusion and self-advocacy. The Missouri Quality Outcomes fuel important conversations regarding individual rights and serve as a basis for the Division's quality improvement initiatives.

National Core Indicators (NCI) is an effort by participating DD state agencies to measure and track their own performance. Every year, NCI produces an At-a-Glance Report, which provides a snapshot of their most interesting and relevant data. Building off of this idea, the Division decided to use the At-a-Glance format to showcase the Missouri Quality Outcomes and supporting data. The goal is to inform our stakeholders (individuals who receive services and their families, staff, providers, etc.) of survey data that highlights areas of services and supports in need of enhancement to meet the Missouri Quality Outcomes.

This initial report provides an overview of the Missouri Quality Outcomes with data from various NCI surveys and the Missouri Quality Outcomes survey. In addition, it sets the stage for future At-a-Glance Reports, which will examine each outcome in detail with relevant data sets and resources.
