Ozark Training Initiative Update	E. Fitzsimmons-Craft presented information on update. Conducted 4 months follow up survey. A total of 44 eating disorder cases treated since training (Jan. 26 &27) at least 16 cases treated specifically with IPT. Had great feedback.

	E. Fitzsimmons-Craft stated that there are 51 providers to attend the Aug. 4 training in St. Louis. Attendees include 6 physicians, 3 nurse practitioners, 14 nurses, 7 dietitians, 21 therapist (includes teams from our Centers of Excellence). We have a waitlist of 49 other people (mostly therapist). This training will be recorded and will be put online.

In the fall of 2017 M. Firebaugh is trying to get a "kickoff event" at each university. She also stated that she is still discussing with the liaisons to schedule these events.
