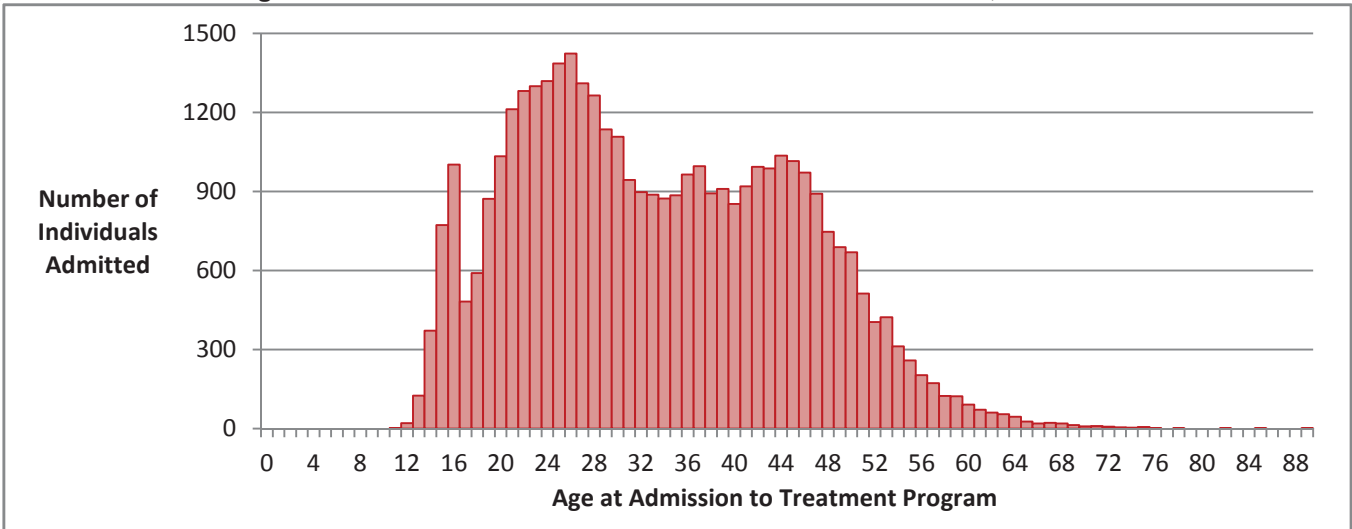

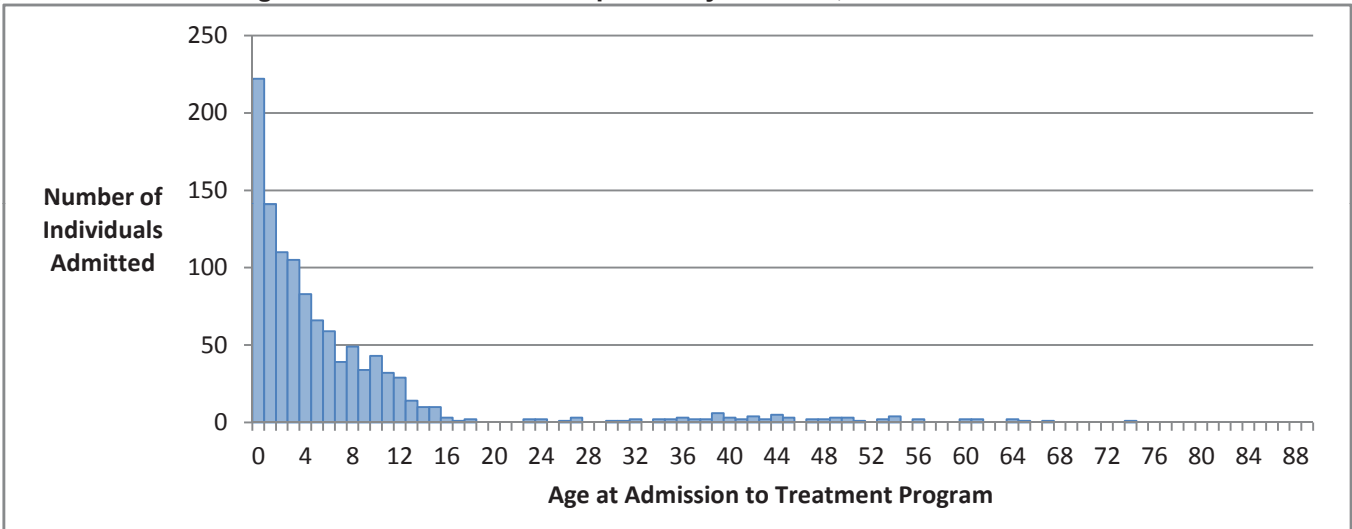
AGE PROFILES OF ADA PROGRAM ADMISSIONS

Age Profile of ADA Program Admissions for Substance Abuse Clinical Treatment, Fiscal Year 2008



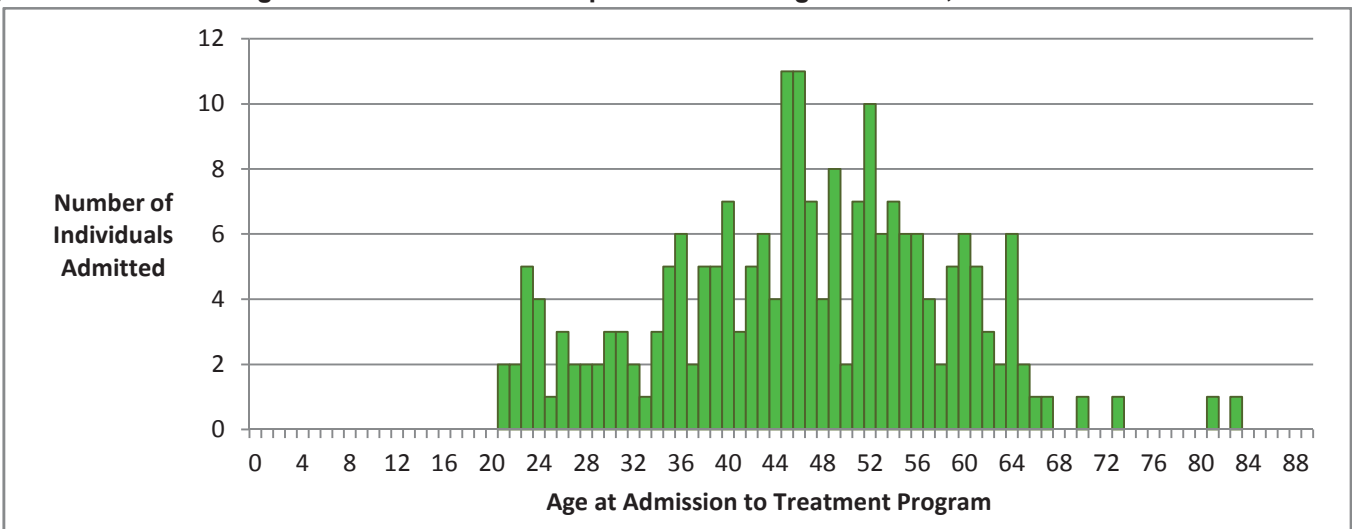
