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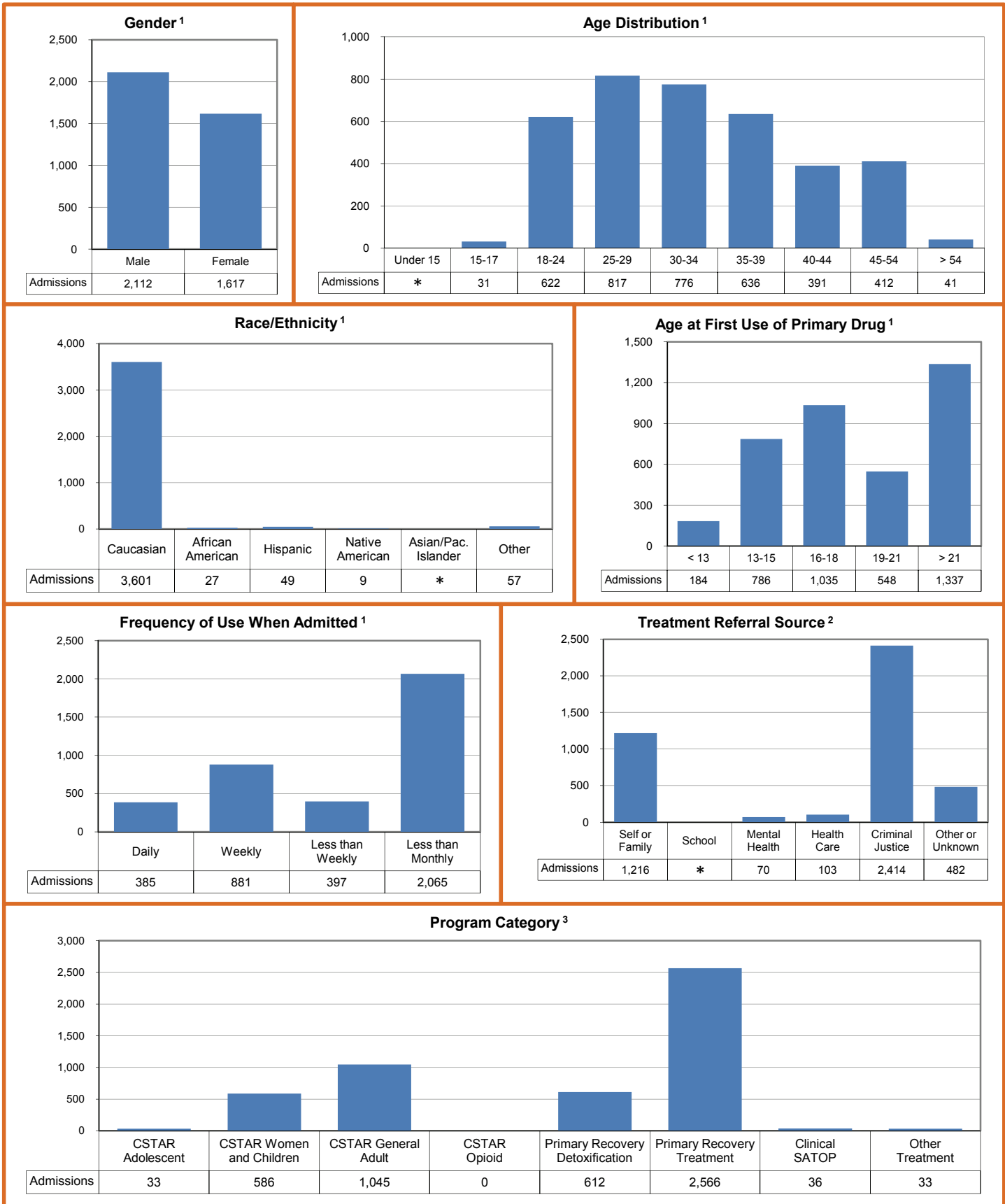


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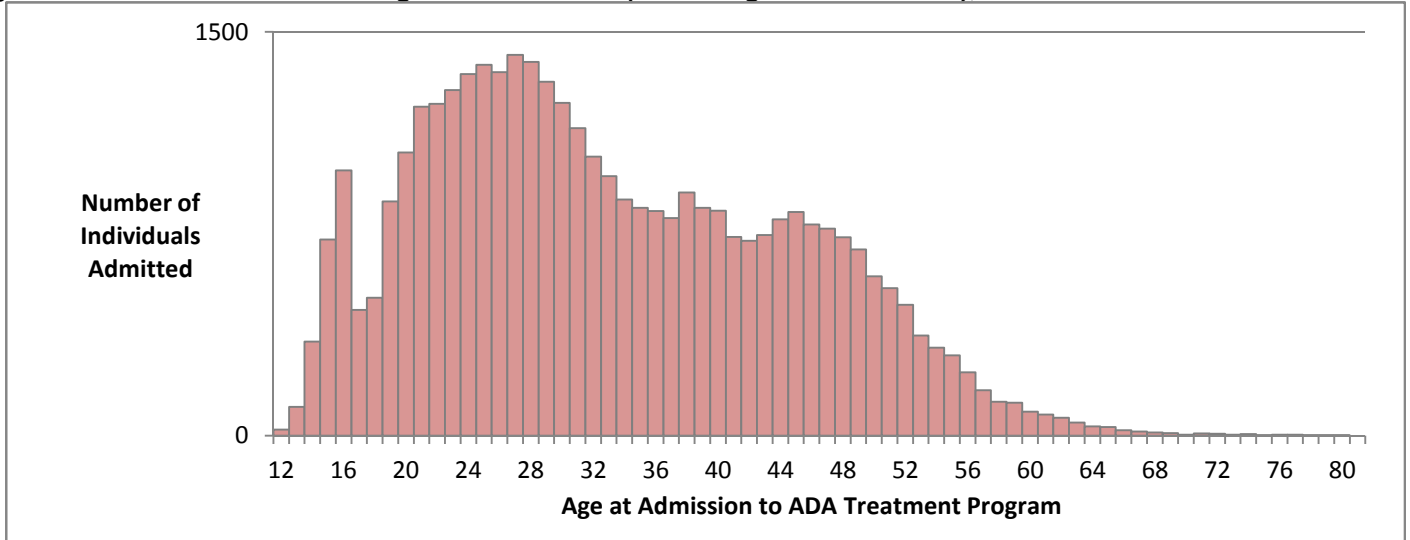
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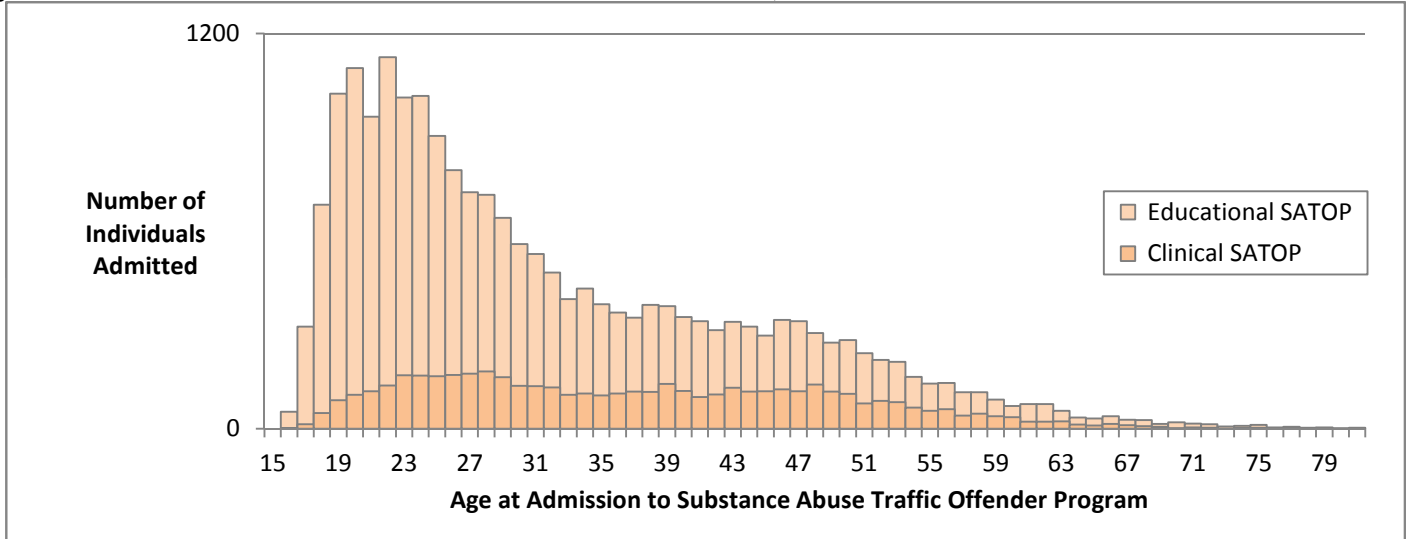
AGE PROFILES OF TREATMENT PROGRAM ADMISSIONS

Age Profile of ADA Treatment Program Admissions (Excluding Clinical SATOP), Fiscal Year 2010



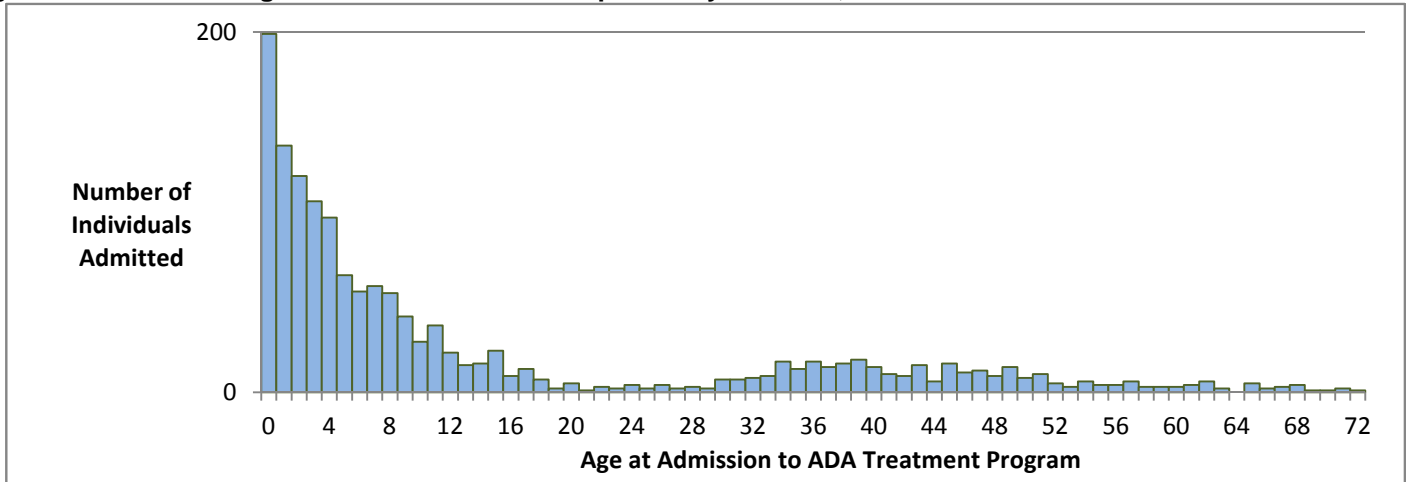
