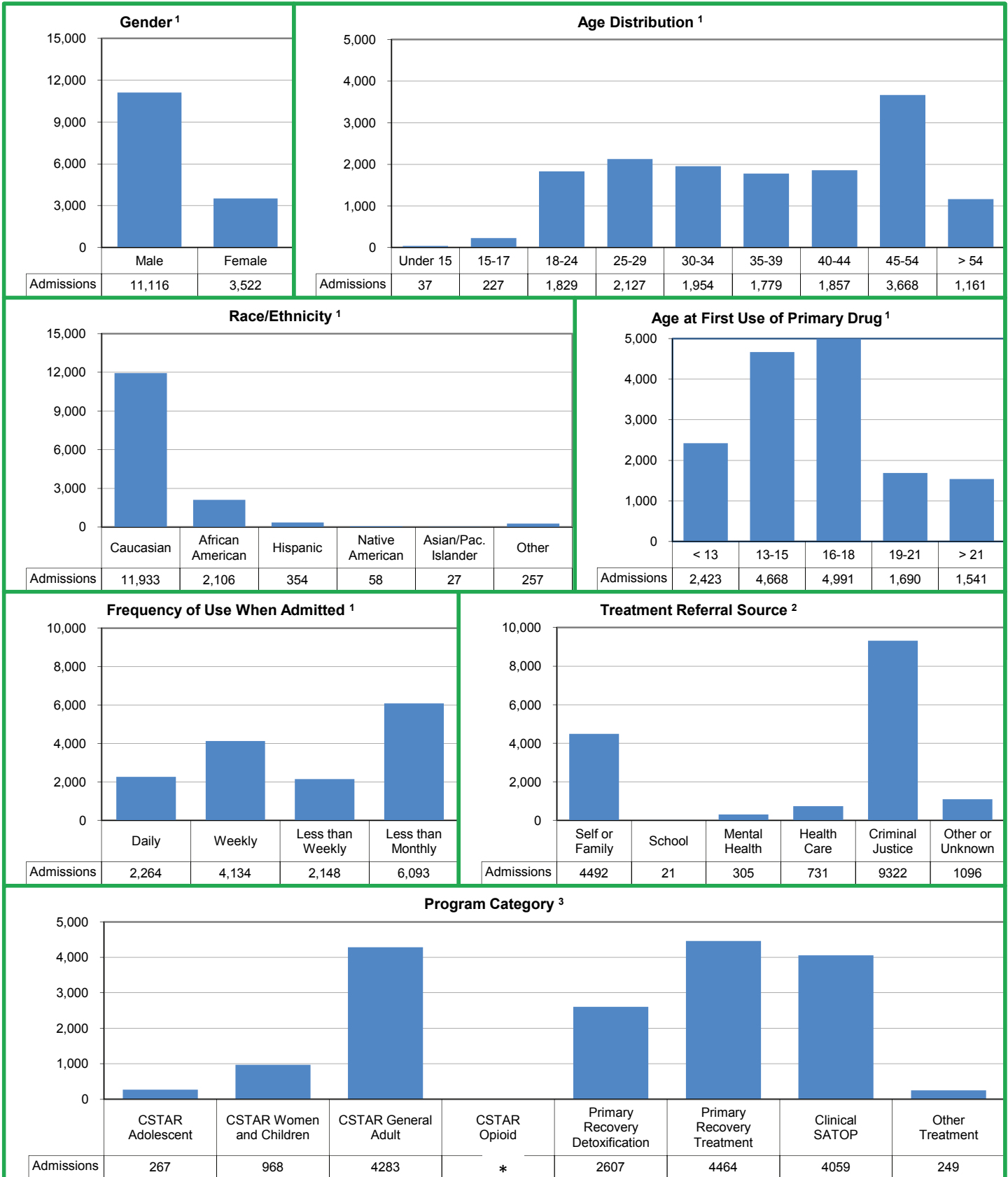

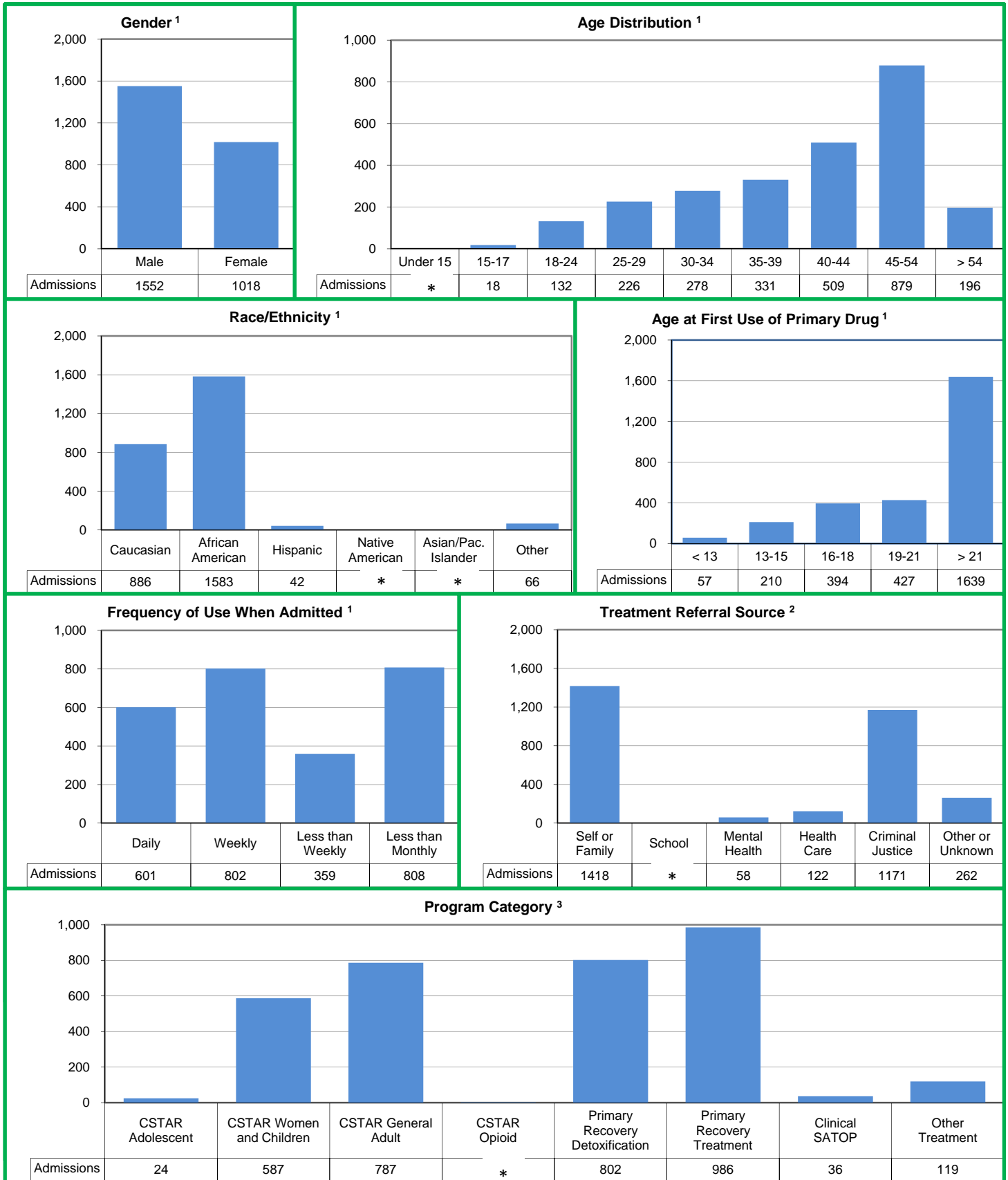
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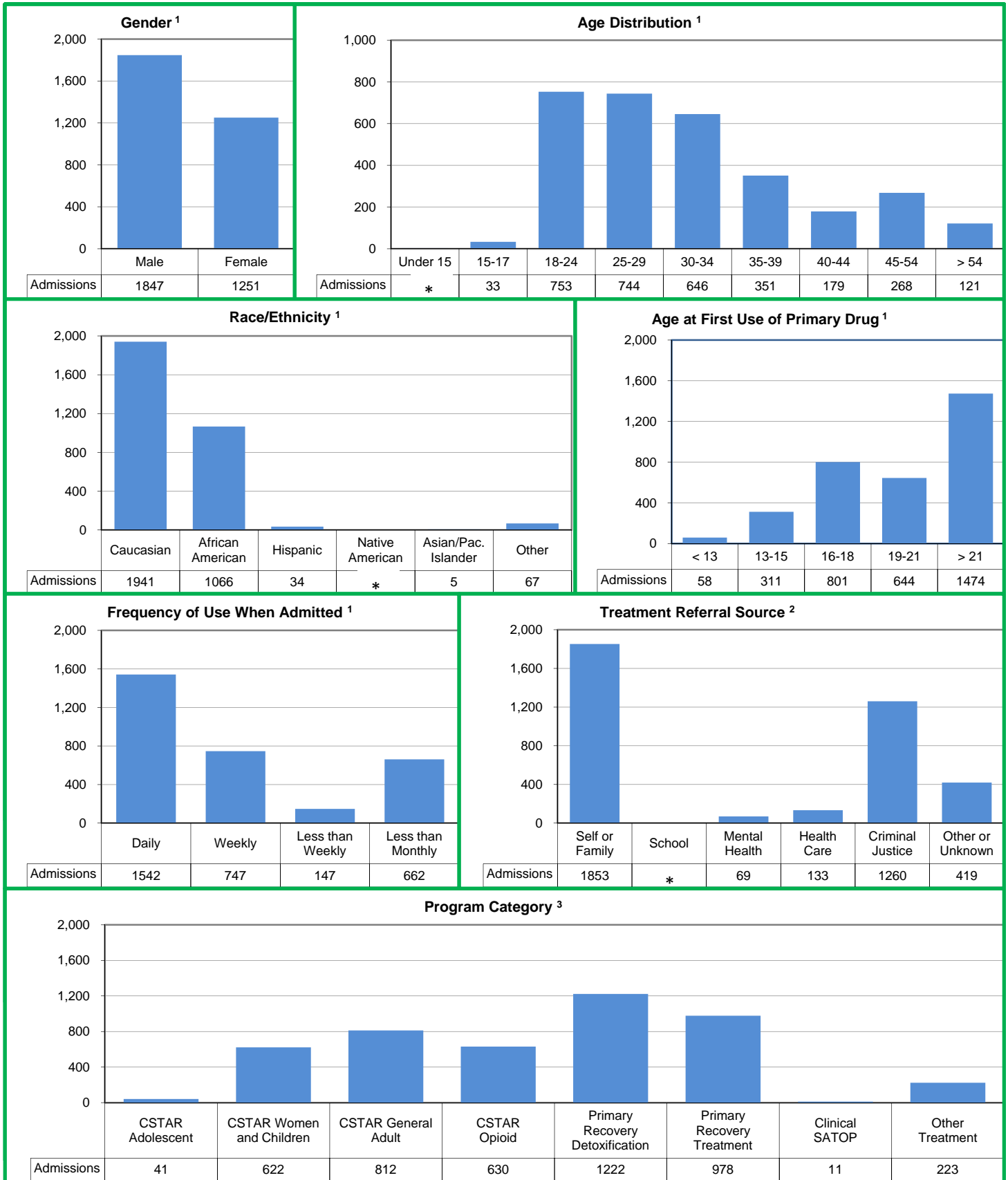


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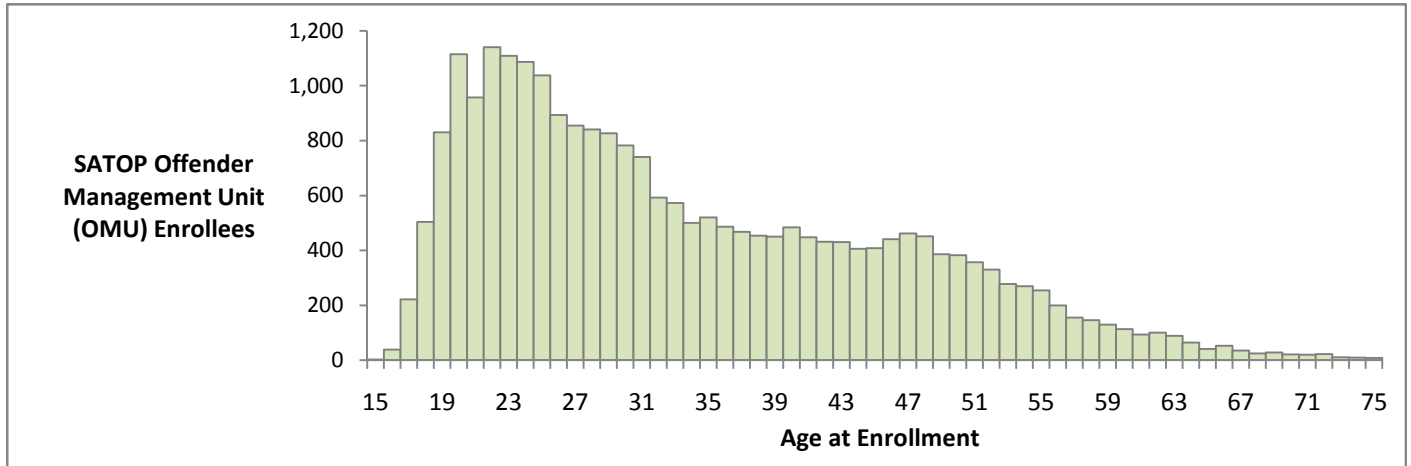
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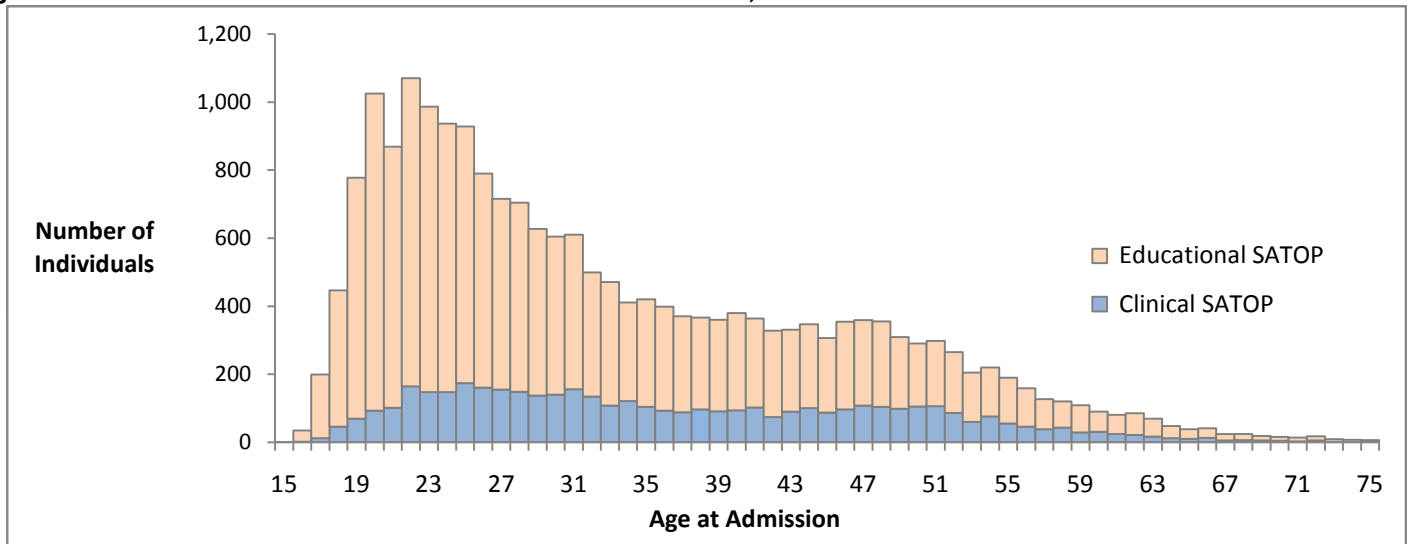
## AGE PROFILES OF ADA INTERVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAM ADMISSIONS

### Age Profile of Individuals Assigned to Substance Abuse Traffic Offender Program (SATOP), Fiscal Year 2011



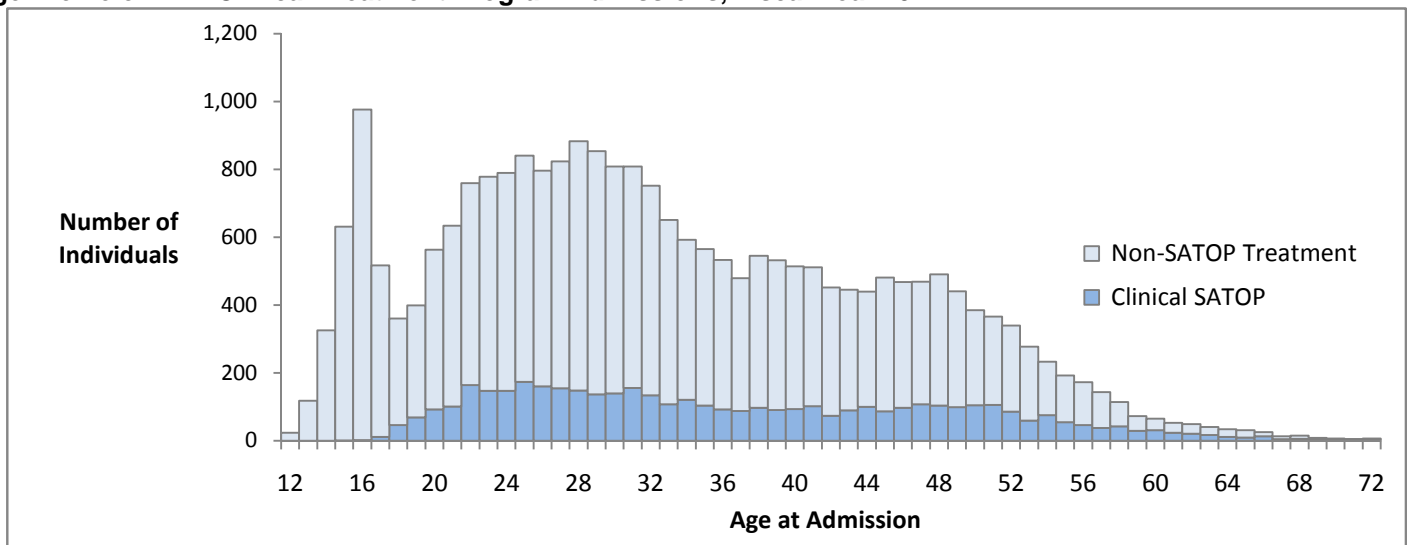
