Foundations of Coordinating Employment Supports

This three-part series is designed to provide Support Coordinators with a foundation of information, resources, and strategies to promote employment for individuals receiving waiver services.

[Session 1](#) - February 16 - provides the basis for exploring an individual's desire to work and how Support Coordinators help coordinate employment supports. Attendees will learn about the importance of employment in a person's life and how state and federal initiatives relate to employment and Support Coordination.

[Session 2](#) - February 23 - provides Support Coordinators with a toolkit to help individuals achieve their desired employment outcomes. Attendees will discover what employment services are available under Partnership for Hope, Community Support, and Comprehensive Waivers; how these services can be utilized; who could benefit from these services; what information is needed to request services; and what the outcome requirements are for these services.

Session 3 - [March 2](#) & [March 7](#) - combines information from the first two sessions to discover how Support Coordinators can determine strategies useful in discussing employment as well as resources available to address barriers to employment. This session is being offered twice to accommodate/allow for two smaller discussion groups.
