
#### What is the Missouri Youth Leadership Forum?



- A 5-day career leadership training program for individuals who have disabilities ages 16 -21.
- The Forum is held at the University of Missouri in Columbia.
- The program was first developed by the California Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities 1992.
- Missouri held its first Forum in 2001, since then 362 delegates have graduated from the program.
- The 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Missouri Youth Leadership Forum (MO-YLF) dates are July 18-22, 2023.

## Who Can Apply?



- Students who are ages 16 21
- Live in Missouri
- Demonstrate Potential Leadership Skills
- Disclose a disability

- Complete the MO-YLF application.
- Applications must be submitted before <u>April 15th</u>
- Be sure to follow all directions. You must submit the application, a resume, and answer the essay questions.

- Meet with leaders in the disability community, keynote speaker, alumni, mentors and employers




- Opportunity to get a glimpse into the 5-day MO-YLF at MU Campus
