Assessment Capacity Bridge Plan Updates

The Assessment Capacity Bridge Plan and corresponding materials have been updated to reflect current guidance and provide additional clarity.

Important Highlights:

- Support Coordinators should NOT initiate assessment scheduling for Non-Residential Renewals Assessments. Division Assessors are now responsible for scheduling these types of assessments.
- If an adaptive assessment extends beyond three years due to Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) assessment capacity, Support Coordinators should still complete the Level of Care (LOC) Renewal and utilize the "LOC Determination Date" as the "Assessment Date".
- Support Coordinators ARE responsible for initiating assessment scheduling for Residential LOC Renewals, Initial Waiver Requests, and Critical Service Situations
- A Missouri Adaptive Ability Scale (MAAS) is required and should be scheduled for all initial Missouri Children's Developmental (MOCCD) Waiver Requests.
