DHSS and DMH Coordination Process Updated

The [DHSS and DMH Coordination Process](#) in the [Support Coordinator Manual](#) has been updated. Changes include contact information for the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) and updated links to DHSS and Department of Mental Health (DMH) manuals.

The DHSS and DMH Coordination Process is a useful guide that outlines information and processes support coordinators can use to coordinate services with DHSS. The document contains information and guidance on the following areas:

 - Healthy Children and Youth (HCY) Program;
 - Healthy Children and Youth (HCY)/Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) Program and;
 - Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver Services
- DMH DD Support Coordinators Referral Process to DHSS
- DMH DD Support Coordinator Documents in the Individual Support Plan (ISP)
- Special Considerations for State Plan Services
- State Plan Personal Care Services Overview
